THE TOM BALDWIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP was established by a group of individuals, through a fundraising event in the summer of 2005. The resulting endowment purpose is to fund an annual scholarship in memory of Tom Baldwin.

One scholarship is available annually through this fund in the amount of \$1,000.00 to a student who:

- a. Resides within the Peace River Constituency area and is a student of the following school jurisdictions:
 - Peace River School Division No. 10
 - Holy Family Catholic Regional Division
 - Northwest Francophone Education Region No. 1
 - Ft. Vermilion School Division
 - Northland School Division
- b. Is a resident of Alberta as defined by the Alberta Student Finance Regulation,
- c. Is a graduate of a High School located in one of the aforementioned school jurisdictions, whether in the current year or in the previous five years,
- d. In the opinion of his/her teachers, has pursued his/her studies with diligence and honest effort,
- e. Is a credit to his/her home, school and community.
- f. Enrols and is accepted as a full-time student at a post-secondary institution recognized by Alberta Advanced Education.
- g. Agrees to return to Northern Alberta (as defined by the boundaries of the Northern Alberta Development Council) to work for a minimum of two years.
- h. Applies to the Northern Alberta Development Council's (NADC) Bursary Partnership Program.

The selection of the recipient will be based on the following:

- 1. A typewritten, double-spaced essay, maximum 3 pages outlining:
 - the applicant's knowledge of the career they have decided to pursue
 - > how their chosen career supports society in Northern Alberta
 - > their commitment to Northern Alberta and their community through the community activities they have engaged in

The essay should also include information about the applicant's contribution to & involvement in their home, school and community.

- 2. A letter of reference from a teacher.
- 3. A marks statement verified by the school principal or designate.
- 4. A completed Northern Alberta Development Council Bursary Partnerships Program Student Application.

For students in Grade 12, please ensure that you return your completed application to the school principal by June 30th. Your school principal will then return the completed application, along with your marks statement, by September 15th of the school year following the candidate's graduation to:
